#18 Mono Canvas Victorian Green 4" by 6"

#5 Perle Cotton #815

#12 Braid 210

#12 Braid 31

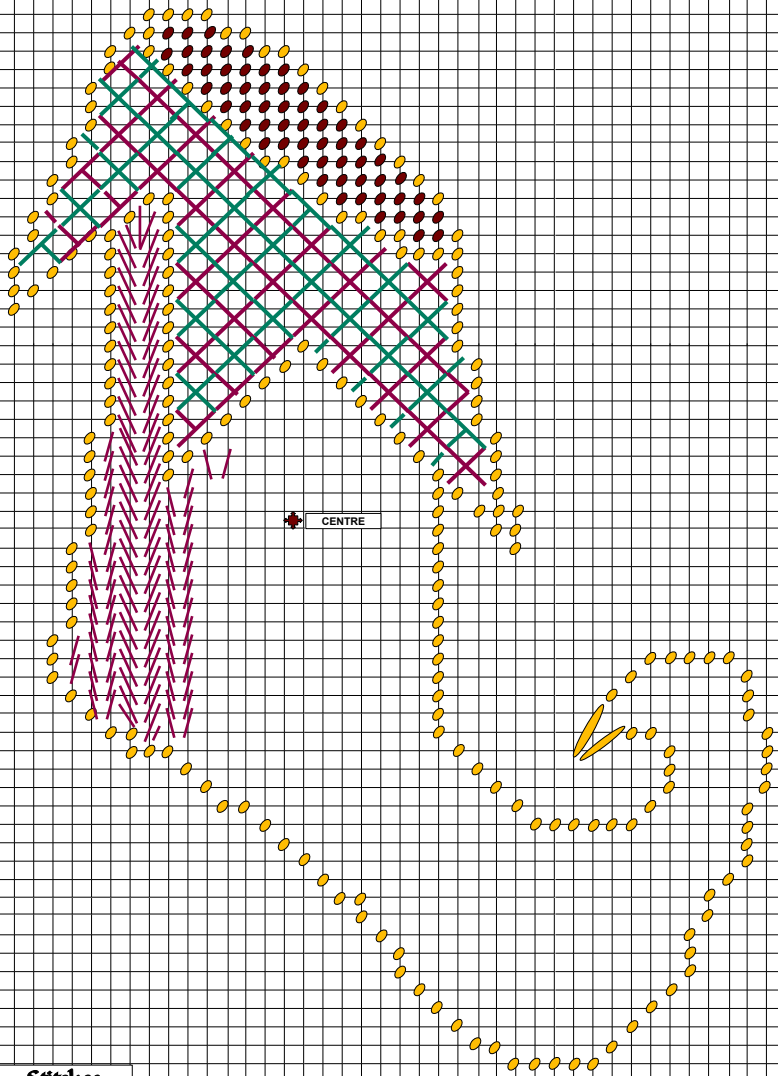
#12 Braid 85

Impressions 2071

Tiny bell

1 Oval Card Dark Green

#22 Tapestry Needle

As Christmas draws near many families hang their stockings by the chimney (this was originally to dry them) in hopes that St. Nick would soon be there. Children plead under their breath "Santa, please fill my stocking. I have been good!"

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Find the centre of the canvas and the centre of the chart. Count over to the outline on the right hand side.
2. Using #12 Braid 210 stitch the outline in Continental Stitch. Note the Elongated Stitch on the toe to give it more shape.
3. Using #5 Perle Cotton 815 stitch the inside portion of the stocking using Continental Stitch.
4. Stitch the Cross Stitch inside the cuff area using #12 Braid 31 and #12 Braid 85. They do alternate so follow the chart carefully. Work one colour then the other.
5. Using Impressions 2071 work the Knit Stitch, filling in the entire stocking. Smaller stitches may be required along the edges at the top and bottom to fill in completely.
6. Add the bell to the front point of the cuff.

Trim canvas and insert into card opening, tape in place. Send to all who dream of having a Full Stocking!
